

DF Registration & Fees Document 2026-2027

Registration

1. Read Policies and Procedures thoroughly. Please visit our website for additional information godancefusion.com. Email us at godancefusion@yahoo.com with any questions.
2. I communicate primarily through our private Dance Fusion Parents Facebook page.
3. Fully complete Student Registration/ Emergency Form in its entirety. This form must be initialed, signed and dated by a parent or guardian.
4. Turn in or mail completed forms, along with an annual \$50 nonrefundable registration fee for new dancers or a returning dancer early registration fee of \$30 (by rehearsal).
5. First day of fall classes is **Monday, August 10th, 2026.**

Placement & Monthly Tuition (August – May)

We place students in our classes by age, skill level & past attendance, along with many other factors. If your instructor feels that your dancer might be better suited in another class, we will make another placement assessment in order to find the right fit for everyone.

Tuition for dancer's 8+ first class:	\$70 per month
Second class:	\$25 per month
Third class:	\$20 per month

***Sibling Discount:** For the second dancer's first class - \$40 per month.

*Add \$20.00 per class per month for any additional classes taken by the second dancer.

Pay in full discount: Families who choose to pay tuition in full by August 31st will receive a 10% discount.

*All tuition and fees are non-refundable.

Fees

1. The registration fee is nonrefundable. This fee is paid upon registration.
2. Monthly tuition is due on the 1st of the month. Monthly fees remain the same regardless of the number of lessons taught within a month due to holidays or absences and are nonrefundable.
3. A late fee of \$20 will be assessed for payments received after the 10th of the month. NO EXCEPTIONS. On the 11th, we will add the fee to your monthly tuition and run the credit card on file. A \$25 NSF fee will be added onto all insufficient fund checks.

Recital Fee

A Recital Fee of \$200 per family will cover the cost of the theater rental, theater personnel, props, staff, scenery, rehearsal, 1 programme book, video link, and other associated costs. This fee also includes 5 recital tickets (dancers do not need a ticket). Any additional tickets will be \$15 per ticket and are available on a first come first serve basis.

***This fee of \$200 will be due at your dancer's first dance class along with August tuition and is non-refundable.**

Costume Fees

All dancers will have a required costume to be purchased per dance as well as a recital shirt that will be worn for the finale. Your costume fee will be divided into two payments. Half of your total costume fee will be due in October. The remaining balance will be due in November. These fees are non-refundable.

Adult Costume Sizes:	\$80 per costume
Adult Tights:	\$22 per pair
Finale Shirt:	\$20 (all dancers)
Earrings:	\$16 per pair

Accepted forms of Payment

Monthly invoices will be sent and payments can be made directly on the invoice emailed. We also accept VISA, Master Card, Discover, Debit, Checks, and Cash.

Class Procedures

Please have your dancer arrive 5 minutes prior to class start time dressed in the proper attire and shoes. You will be notified via email your dancer's schedule, exact shoes and other important info that will be needed for their class prior to shoe fitting. Proper technical warm-ups are done at the beginning of class and are vital to preventing injuries. Dancers must have appropriate shoes on or will be asked to not participate. Hair must be up and out of face.

Jazz & Tap: Moveable clothing; Leotard, booty shorts, tank, jazz pants, etc...

Hip Hop: Loose comfortable clothing; T-shirt, sweatpants, shorts etc....

Technique/Contemporary: Moveable clothing; Leotard, booty shorts, tank, jazz pants, etc...

Dance Shoes

All shoes & tights will be through Toptoe Dancewear located at 4710 O'Neal Lane.

*Dancers ages 5 and up are allowed to bring a spill proof water only to dance class. Cell phones must be turned off or left at home.
